for 2010 Educators Tour to China, by CACBC

Scholarships Deadline (all 3): February 1, 2010

Gold Scholarship - \$1,500

Silver Scholarship - \$1,000

Bronze Scholarship - \$500

Guideline: CACBC is providing three scholarships for educators who are participating in our 2010 Educators Tour to China, all three scholarship amount can only go toward the 2010 Educators Tour to China. Each one scholarship can be shared up to 3 people, in which case the scholarship amount will be divided equally among those educators. Educators can choose between Itinerary A of 12 days, or a different route Itinerary B of 15 days. At the end of the trip each scholarship winners have to present a workshop regarding what they have learned on their trip to China for their community, which will mark the completion of their scholarship.

Eligibility to apply

It is intended that applicants who meet the following criteria may apply:

- Applicants who are educators, such as teachers, principals, administrators, professors within the 50 United states, Canada and Puerto Rico.
- Currently in a full time position within an accredited institution
- Attending the 2010 Educators Tour, either Itinerary A or B

Presentation requirement

At the end of the tour each winning participant will prepare a presentation to be presented at their selected workshop, each presenter will make a presentation for a group of audience using technology (slideshow, videotape, overhead projector...etc) to examine what they have learned on their trip to China whether it is focused on culture, language, art style, ...etc. **A videotape of the participants presentation in the conference will be mailed to CACBC** as a conclusion of the participant's scholarship.

Each winning participant will present their presentation at their selected workshop. Contacting each conference/workshop will be up to the winning participant, if a winning participant could not complete this task then the scholarship will be taken away and another winner will be awarded. Below are the types of workshop each winning participant is oblige by.

Gold Scholarship – workshop at a National Conference of your choice

Silver Scholarship – workshop at a National or Regional Conference of your choice

Bronze Scholarship – workshop at a Regional or Local Conference of your choice
